# Washington Suites Alexandria



The Washington Suites offer spacious accommodations across the Potomac River in Virginia, but convenient to downtown Washington DC.

The Washington Suites building was previously an apartment complex, and it shows in the size of the rooms. All suites feature a kitchen and separate living rooms and sleeping areas.

If you need space to scrimmage, they also have a business center and several conference rooms on-site.

The group rate is not available on their website, so please make reservations by phone or fax. If making reservations by phone, be sure to mention UVA Mock Trial to secure the group rate. If submitting your request by fax, please use the form at the back of this packet.

The location of this hotel is very convenient to the Reagan Airport and to highways into DC, but you will need a car to travel back and forth to the courthouse. On-site parking is free.

#### From Washington Dulles Airport - 26.5 miles (40 minutes)

- Turn left out of the rental car area going towards the terminal
- Turn left at Rudder Road and follow the signs to "Airport Exit"
- As you exit the airport, move to the left and follow the signs that say "To 495 / Washington" to the center, non-toll lanes. (12 miles)
- Take Exit 18 onto I-495 S towards Richmond/Alexandria. (10 miles)
- Take Exit 57B onto I-395 North. (3 miles)
- Take Exit 3A (Duke Street) and merge onto Duke Street. (~1 mile)
- Turn right onto S. Reynolds Street. The hotel will be almost immediately on the left.

#### From Ronald Reagan Airport- 10 miles (15 minutes)

- Take the signs for "Airport Exit" and follow the signs for the GW Parkway going North towards Washington. (~1 mile)
- Exit onto I-395 going South towards Richmond. (7 miles)
- Take Exit 3A (Duke Street) and merge onto Duke Street. (1 mile)
- Turn right onto S. Reynolds Street. The hotel will be almost immediately on the left.

#### From the Hotel to the Courthouse – 10 miles (15 minutes)

- Turn right out of the parking area onto S. Reynolds Street.
- Turn left at the light onto Duke Street (0.5 miles)
- Bear right into the I-395 N ramp to Washington, D.C. (10 minutes)
- When you reach the bridge to DC, stay to the right and on I-395 (not US-1). Move 1-2 lanes to the left.
- After passing several exits, take the right exit marked "395 N/ D Street NW / US Senate"
- When the road splits, stay in the right lane. You will then merge with a road coming in from the right and enter a tunnel. Move quickly to the right.
- Within the tunnel, there will be a right exit (Exit 9) with smallish signs
  that say "U.S. Capitol" and then "U.S. Senate." Take the exit, but stay in
  the lane that is second from the right so that you exit towards D Street
  rather than veering off sharply to the right.
- Immediately as you exit the tunnel, you will come to a stop light at D Street. Turn left.
- Take the next left onto Third Street. You will drive under a building that spans over the road.
- The courthouse will be on your right on the next block.

### Fairfield Inn and Suites Renovated and re-opening March 2011



Formerly the Red Roof Inn, this property will re-open right before our tournament as a Fairfield Inn, fresh from a full renovation. This downtown location is in the heart of DC's Chinatown, just blocks from the Prettyman Courthouse, the Verizon Center (where the Capitals and Wizards play), numerous museums, and literally dozens of restaurants of all cuisines and price ranges.

The Fairfield Inn is just blocks from the Gallery Place-Chinatown Station, which is served by Metrorail's Green, Red, and Yellow lines, so there's no need to rent a car if you'll be arriving via air at Ronald Reagan Airport (Yellow line), via train at Union Station (Red line), or via Chinatown bus (in Chinatown). For those who will be driving, the hotel has first-come, first-serve parking on-site. Other garages are nearby, and there is street parking available on Sundays.

## From Washington Dulles Airport to the Red Roof Inn – 24 miles (30 minutes)

- Turn left out of the rental car area going towards the terminal
- Turn left at Rudder Road and follow the signs to "Airport Exit"
- As you exit the airport, move to the left and follow the signs that say "To 495 / Washington" to the center, non-toll lanes. (15 miles)
- Stay in the center and follow the signs "To 66E / Washington." (DO NOT take the exits to I-495).
   About 16.5 miles after starting your trip, you will automatically merge onto I-66 going East. (8 miles)
- Cross the Potomac River on the Theodore Roosevelt Bridge into DC. Stay in the left two lanes and exit onto "US 50 E / Constitution Avenue / Downtown." The first major cross street will be 23d Street, the Lincoln Memorial will be on your right, and the street numbers should be doing down.
- Take a left on 7th Street.
- Take a right on H Street.
- The Red Roof will be in a block and a half on the right.

## From Ronald Reagan Airport to the Red Roof Inn – 4.6 miles (11 minutes)

- Take the signs for "Airport Exit" and follow the signs for the GW Parkway going North towards Washington. (~1 mile)
- When you reach the bridge to D.C., stay to the right and on I-395 (Do not take the US-1 exit). Move 1-2 lanes to the left.
- After passing several exits, take the exit marked "395 N/ D Street NW / US Senate"
- When the road splits, stay in the right lane. You will then merge with a road coming in from the right and enter a tunnel. Move quickly to the right.
- Within the tunnel, there will be a right exit (Exit 9) with smallish signs that say "U.S. Capitol" and then "U.S. Senate." Take the exit, but stay in the lane that is second from the right so that you exit towards D Street rather than veering off sharply to the right.
- Immediately as you exit the tunnel, you will come to a stop light at D Street. Turn left.
- Turn right onto 6th Street NW
- Turn right onto H Street NW. (The hotel is at 500 H Street NW)
